




Data deep dive: who's reading & top 10




January 2022 reflects our best month in circulation since inception date (May 17, 2021)



Books opened shows how engaged students are with what they are reading. 47,838 checkouts but some books opened more than once.




Our Multicultural collection is growing and gaining momentum

Top Subject by Checkout




Top 10 titles by Checkout January 1 - 31, 2022


