
Content purchased at district level Accessible by all students and staff in district

Set and control permissions for advantage accounts



Advantage Account

A sub-account that allows a school to purchase additional content just for their students and staff and allows them to curate Sora with collections specifically for their school population.



Assign titles to individuals or groups


- Assign audio book to accompany print for ELL's
