Data deep dive: who's reading & top 10

Since May 2021, we have seen over 358,736 books borrowed and over 138,635 hours read. The latest data is below, but you also have access to this data for your district. If you would like to learn how to access your own usage data please reach out to <u>lody</u> or <u>Victoria</u>.





Let's look at 2022 data! Data since January 1, 2022

- 137,908 checkouts
- 67,392 hours read

March 1 – March 31, 2022

- 53,255 checkouts!
- 24,766 hours read!







Books opened shows how engaged students are with what they are reading. 137,908 checkouts but some books opened more than once.

Students logged in as Young Adult (grades 6-8) spend more time reading. There was an increase in reading hours from Jan-Feb within Juvenile students (K-5) and a decrease in Adult readers (9-12).



Top Subject by Checkout

The above chart shows our checkout activity by subject. The larger the box the higher the circulation. Juvenile fiction is our favorite subject area, followed by Juvenile Literature, Comic & Graphics, Humor, Juvenile Nonfiction, and Young Adult Fiction
